




LOCATION & ACCESS


The Krug Property is centred at 41⁰ 05.4' N 118 '20.3 W in Humboldt County. It is 99 km NE of Gerlach and 60 km WNW of Winnemucca. The property is accessible by 4WD trails branching from the Jungo Road 24 km south of the property. The property consists of 8 Federal lode claims staked in Sections 07, 12 & 18, Township 37N, Range 32/33E on BLM land. There are no special surface land use restrictions on these lands.

Property Summary


The Krug Property is located in the Jungo Mining District in Humboldt County. The property covers apparent mesothermal mineralization in Triassic to Jurassic granodiorite intruding PermoTriassic metasedimentary and metavolcanic rocks. Initial grab samples returned analyses up to 3.54 g/t Au and 340 g/t Ag from mineralized veins. There are numerous shafts, adits and pits on the property and evidence of small scale production from one showing.
